APPLICATIONS



PERSONAL FALL ARREST:

Truss Boss anchors may be used in Personal Fall Arrest applications to support:

- Maximum 1 Personal Fall Arrest System (PFAS).
 Structure must withstand loads applied in the directions permitted by the system of at least 5,000 lbs.
- Maximum allowable free fall is 6'.
- Applicable D-rings: Dorsal.



WORK POSITIONING:

Truss Boss anchors may be used in Work Positioning applications.

- Work Positioning systems allow a worker to be supported while in suspension and work freely with both hands.
- Structure must withstand loads applied in the directions permitted by the system of at least 3,000 lbs.
- Maximum allowable free fall is 2'.
- Applicable D-rings: Side.



RESTRAINT:

Truss Boss anchors may be used in Fall Restraint applications to support:

- Maximum 1 PFAs
- Prevent workers from reaching the leading edge of a fall hazard.
- Always account for fully deployed length of SRL.
 Structure must withstand loads applied in the directions permitted by the system of at least 1,000 lbs.
- No free fall is permitted.
- May only be used on surfaces with slopes up to 4/12 (vertical/horizontal).
- Applicable D-rings: Dorsal, Chest, Side, & Shoulder.
